POST COVID-19 CAPE MAY: RE-OPENING JUNE 1, 2020

To Our Valued Guests and Friends,

The Henry Sawyer Inn is in its 29th Year of continuous family operation. Cleanliness, graciousness, and personal attention are our hallmarks. While these will not change, they will be delivered in some new and creative ways to ensure not only everyone's enjoyment, but most of all, everyone's safety. Taking care of each guest is primary. Our normal check-in time will be pushed back to 3:00 PM, so our staff has more time to prepare everything perfectly. We ask that you continue to follow the guidelines for frequent hand washing. In addition, please use the hand sanitizer we are providing on the front porch and on the tables in the first and second floor halls, as we want to do everything to keep you safe.

In some cases, you will see changes in some rooms. Hopefully, you will love the new look, but most importantly, you will know that everything has been washed and sanitized in keeping with CDC guidelines before your arrival. For the present, we will not be refreshing your room during your stay. We will provide sanitized towels in your room when you check in. If you need additional towels, glasses, or anything else, you can let us know. We will provide a clean plastic bag in which you can place your used towels and leave the bag outside your door for pick up. If you wish to empty your trash, you can remove the small plastic trash bag from its container, tie it at the top, and leave it outside of your room.

We now have breakfast options: no breakfast, continental breakfast to go, or a seated served breakfast. For the latter, we will have two sittings with social distancing: 8:00 AM and 9:00 AM. We will have one table for two people on the porch, one table in the parlor for two to four people who are traveling together, and we will seat two or three people traveling together at each end of our dining room table at a distance of 6 feet apart. We will try our best to honor your seating and time preferences for breakfast. We will be serving you with gloves and facial coverings, and while interacting with our staff or other guests, we ask that you maintain a social distance or wear your own facial covering.

During the day and evening, you will see us sanitizing public spaces and touchable surfaces. Our outside beach shower will be closed. We are requesting that you remove sand and wash feet at the beach. Sanitized beach towels will be provided to you at the start of your stay, and as usual, at the end of each day, we ask that you deposit the used beach towels in the basket at the rear of the inn.

We are using a touchless check-in and check-out system. If you wish to pay us by credit card, we will run your card the day before arrival; the specific amount with tax will be included in your confirmation. If you are paying us by check or cash, we ask that you provide the exact amount in an envelope and present it to us at the time of check in. Check out will also be touchless and will remain at 11:00 AM. As you say "good-bye," we ask that you leave your room keys on the first-floor hall desk.

We value your presence in our lives, and we look forward to welcoming you back to the Henry Sawyer Inn. As always, if there is anything, we can do to make your stay safer or more enjoyable, we will do it.
